each judge may individually access the Practice Test and Official Test. The login and password for the STS Educational platform will NOT give access to the Practice Test or Official Test.

The national federations may also register a maximum of 10 new brevet judges in each discipline. For these new judges, a new profile will need to be created in the Sport Database, and as soon as possible, while respecting the deadlines set out in the Test Schedule. The FIG will need to validate (as quickly as possible) these new judges before tests (ID numbers for dates & time zones) can be selected by the NF for each judge. Then the database will provide the online access information, login = their judge ID number and a password. This information will need to be sent to each judge SEPARATELY so each judge may access the Practice Test and Official Test. The login and password for the STS Educational platform will NOT give access to the Practice Test or Official Test.

Test Stages

For candidates there are two stages for the STS Tests system:

- 1) Practice Tests that familiarize candidates with the login, video display quality and data entry input for their discipline.
- 2) Official Test

Practice Test

One week before each Official Test, candidates will have the opportunity to enter the STS Tests site to practice and prepare for the Official Test. The goal is to have all candidates for a specific test on the STS Tests platform to test their hardware and connection, and at the same time, allow STS to confirm all their systems are working optimally.

All candidates should login 10-15 minutes before their sessions. The Practice Test is just a sample to get familiar with the input screens and no answers or results will be shown. The Practice Test can be completed in approximately 30 minutes.

Once the Practice Test is over, candidates will have access to it and may repeat taking it until the day of the Official Test. If a judge is unable to attend the practice session or has connection issues, they should contact STS through their website "Contact Us".

Official Test

All candidates should login 10-15 minutes before their sessions. More information on the format and breaks (if any) will be specified in the next edition of the Test Directives. One important feature to mention is the "Submit" button. Candidates have two choices when they complete their input: 1) hit the submit button and immediately move to the next routine or 2) wait until time expires and anything entered will be automatically captured as their result.

Final Candidate Results

Tests will be administered on a 'pass/fail' basis. Final results will be sent to each NF once rechecked by the FIG office and confirmed by the respective TC President.

Judging Input Screens for the Tests

The input screen examples will be available in the next edition of the Test Directives after approval by the TC Presidents.

Hardware / WiFi Recommendations and Connection Issues

Do not use a mobile phone for the Practice Test or Official Test. The tests can run best on PCs, MACs and full-size tablets. A mouse or stylus is recommended, but not required.

The Chrome browser is recommended for the STS Educational websites, Practice Tests and Official Tests.

If you lose connection, the test will resume from the same place you last had connection, however, you only have a 20-minute window to resume the test. If necessary, a candidate can restart their test on a different device and/or a different WiFi or hardwire network.
